

## BA/BSc Top-up students How do I access my Kick-Start funds?



If you are a new UK BA/BSc Top-up student, you will receive up to £300 Kick-Start funds once you are fully enrolled. UK students with an assessed household income of below £25,000 will be entitled to a further £500 at the start of second semester (i.e. September).

These funds do not need to be paid back and can be used at [www.ucb-kickstart.co.uk](http://www.ucb-kickstart.co.uk) to order resources such as books, laptops, stationery and anything else that you may need. You can also use your Kick-Start card to spend some of these funds on selected on-campus purchases such as food and drink. Once you are fully enrolled, you will receive an email to your UCB email account to let you know that your Kick-Start funds have been awarded. You will become fully enrolled only after **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January**.

Your username is your student ID followed by [@student.ucb.ac.uk](mailto:@student.ucb.ac.uk). For example [ABC12345678@student.ucb.ac.uk](mailto:ABC12345678@student.ucb.ac.uk). Your password is the same as the one you set when you did online enrolment.
